To the Honorable William Paac Esq
Judge of the District Court for the
Maryland District

Humly complering & sheweth unto you
Honor your Libellant Richard Lawrence
of Baltimore County Blacksmith that
on or about the Thirty first day of August
in the year seven hundred and Eighty
nine on the High Seas and within the
Jurisdiction of this Court to wit at the
Port of Baltimore he was hired and employed
by John Kemp Master and Commander of
the Brigantine called the Juliana now
riding at anchor in the said Port of
Baltimore to repair and amend the said
Brigantine her Tackle Apparel and
Furniture; And your Libellant with
at the special Instance and request of
the said John Kemp as aforesaid and upon
the Credit of the said Brigantine and with
out any knowledge of the Owners he did in
a faithful and workmanlike Manner Repair
and amend the said Brigantine her Tackle
Apparel and Furniture and did also then

and there find and provide divers Materials
and necessary things used in and about the
said Work, or by a particular account thereof
herewith produced reference being thereto
had will more fully appear. And you
Libellant saith, that for the Work and
repairs done and performed by him or
for him in and upon the said Adventure
and for the divers Materials and necessary
things used in and about the said Work he
reasonably deserves to have and receive
the sum of Twenty six pounds Fifteen
Shillings and Current Money of Maryland
And you Libellant further saith that
he has frequently applied to and requested
the said John Kemp Master to pay and
satisfy him for the above mentioned Work
and Materials and that the said John
Kemp has invariably informed him that
he is altogether unable to pay the same.
And you Libellant further saith that he
is otherwise informed and has reason to
believe that the said John Kemp is
Insolvent, And you Libellant further

sath that the real owner of the said
Argentine Juliana is not known to
him and that the reputed owner cannot
now be found by you Libellant, and you
Libellant further sath that he is informed
and has reason to believe that the said
reputed owner has absconded with a view
to evade the payment of this and other
claims against him.

You Libellant further sath that he
cannot obtain relief in the premises but
by the Interposition of this Honorable
Court, and therefore pray that you Honor
that an Attachment may be issued against
the said Argentine Juliana her Trunk
Apparel and Furniture and that the
same may by the Order of this Honorable
Court be sold for the payment of the
above-mentioned sum of Twenty six pounds
and fifteen Shillings due as aforesaid
unto you Libellant and so forth.
