ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2002-3

It is hereby ORDERED that:

1. Unless reasonable steps have been taken to notify the court, a defendant detained in the custody of the United States Marshal for the District of Maryland on charges filed in this District who has not yet been sentenced shall not be transported outside of the District for any reason other than the defendant's own health or safety or a lack of detention space within the District; and

2. No attorney for the government shall seek an order dismissing any charge filed against a defendant represented in this District by counsel without giving prior notice to defense counsel or obtaining permission from the court not to provide such notice.
