**STANDING ORDER NO. 2008-1**

Pursuant to the Requirements of the E-Government Act of 2002 and effective April 21, 2008, transcripts of proceedings before the U.S. District Judges and Magistrate Judges in the District of Maryland taken by Official Court Reporters and Contract Reporters are now required to be filed with the Court in electronic format. The Court will follow the Judicial Conference policy on electronic availability of transcripts of court proceedings before making official transcripts of court proceedings electronically available to the public. This will apply to all transcripts of proceedings or parts of proceedings ordered on or after this date, regardless of when the proceeding took place. Transcripts of voir dire will only be available to counsel of record, court users, and at the public terminals in the Clerk's Office.
